Tipp City Leaf Pickup Schedule for 2010

The Tipp City Street Department continues the leaf pickup program as listed below. There are a few important guidelines to follow. Residents are asked to rake leaves into the street, one foot from the curb, so that storm water will drain. Please, NO limbs, sticks, bricks, rocks or yard debris should be placed with the leaves in the street. These items cause damage to the equipment, create down time for repairs, and add delay to the leaf pickup schedule.

November 15 – 19 Areas throughout the City as needed. Areas between I-75 and N. Hyatt St., North of W. Main St. (this includes Westedge, Tippecanoe (Indian) Village, and Manchester Chase)

November 22 – 26 All areas East of Hyatt Street

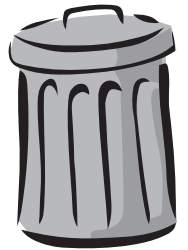
November 29 – Dec. 3 Areas between I-75 and S. Hyatt St., South of W. Main St. (this includes Roslyn, Hathaway, Springhill, Cottonwood, York Meadows, Hampton Woods, and Sycamore Woods)

December 6 – 10 Areas West of I-75, North of W. Main St. (this includes Tipp Commerce Park, Woodlawn, Windmere, and Oakwinds)

December 13 – 17 Clean-up throughout the City as needed



Trash Pick-Up Delay



Due to the Thanksgiving holiday, trash pick-up on Thursday, November 25 and Friday, November 26 will be delayed one day. The schedule will not change during the weeks of Christmas and New Years as both fall on Saturday.

Tipp City Traffic Signal Interconnect Project

Tipp City's Traffic Signal Interconnect Project has begun. Perram Electric of Wadsworth, Ohio was awarded a contract in the amount of \$813,790 to upgrade the traffic signals on W. Main Street (St. Rt. 571) from Co. Rd. 25A east to Hyatt Street.

As part of the project, the signals will be interconnected with fiber to coordinate their timing. The project also includes upgrading the signals at Garber, Tippecanoe and Hyatt with fluted poles and mast arms, matching our existing decorative street lights on Main Street. We will be removing the strain wires and poles that now have the traffic signals attached to them. You may have noticed that Perram has begun excavating and installing the foundations for these poles. They have scheduled the traffic pole installation for the first part of December with the new LED traffic signal installation to follow. The poles will have pedestrian activated buttons with ADA compliant ramps in accordance with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) requirements. Perram plans to be completed by the end of January, depending on the weather.



The City was able to obtain 76% of the funding for this project through

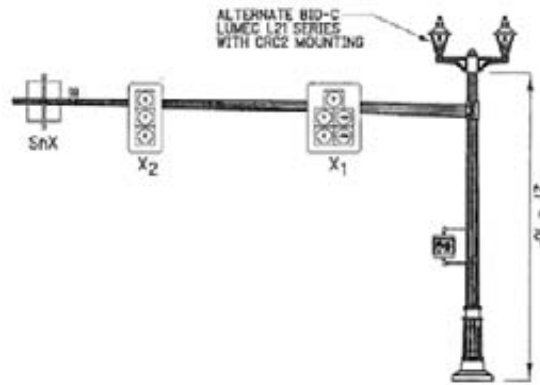
grant funds. ODOT provided \$424,000 or 52% of the funding, \$195,000 or 24% was provide by Ohio Public Works, and the remaining 24% of the funds for the project were provided by Tipp City Electric in the amount of \$195,000. The City could not have contracted this work if it was not for this grant funding. 🍀
