An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 13-81, passed April 6, 1981, which ordinance was approved by the voters on September 8, 1981, and subsequently amended by Ordinances No. 24-02, passed July 15, 2002, and No. 6-11, passed January 31, 2011, and where such amendment is to renew or extend the additional income tax rate in excess of one percent (1%) such that the increase of one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) per annum to the present City of Tipp City Income Tax rate which terminates June 30, 2021 will recommence for the period July 1, 2021 until June 30, 2021 and the increase of one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) per annum to the present City of Tipp City Income Tax rate which terminates December 31, 2022 will recommence for the period January 1, 2023 until December 31, 2032.
