Ordinance 6-21

An ordinance repealing Ordinance 39-90, amended by Ordinance 19-93 Establishing Capital Cost Recovery Fees for the Water/Sewer Main Extensions north of State Route 571, west of Interstate 75, east of Peters Road, and south of the Northern Corporation line.

Ordinance 7-21

An ordinance repealing Ordinance 6-94 Establishing Intervening User Fees for the North-East Sewer Main Extension along Donn Davis Way, E. Kessler-Cowlesville Road, S. Tipp-Cowlesville Road and Crane Road.

An ordinance repealing Ordinance 17-05, amended by Resolution 23-15 Establishing Intervening User Fees for the Water/Sewer Main Extensions on Kessler-Cowlesville, Tipp-Cowlesville (Hyatt) and Crane Roads.
